

BY-LAWS OF THE LEARNING FARM

Article I Name

The name of this corporation is The Learning Farm.

Article II Principal Office

The principal office for the transaction of the business of the corporation is fixed and located at San Diego County. The board of directors may, at any time, or from time to time, change the location of the principal office from one location to another in said county.

Article III Purpose

The specific and primary purposes are to further the education of its members and their families.

Article IV Membership

Section A. Members

1. Parents of all children enrolled in the school shall be members of the corporation.
2. Any other adults who are participating in school activities are eligible to be selected for membership by the Board of Directors.
3. All teachers employed by the school shall be honorary members of the corporation.

Section B. Termination

Membership shall terminate upon the resignation or death of a member or upon expulsion by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

Article V Meetings

Section A. Annual Meetings

There shall be an annual meeting each January of all voting members of the corporation.

Section B. Regular Meetings

Regular meetings shall be held quarterly.

Section C. Special Meetings

Special meetings may be called by any member of the corporation.

Section D. Election of Officers

At the annual meeting nominations will be accepted from the floor and a general election shall be held to select a President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Article VI Board of Directors

Section A. Members

The Board of Directors shall consist of all of the members of the corporation.

Section B. Quorum

A quorum shall consist of all members present at any meetings for which the members have been given at least a twenty-four hour notice.

Section C. Powers of Directors

The Board of Directors shall have the power to conduct, manage, and control the affairs and business of the corporation.

Section D. Term of Office

Directors shall serve indefinitely so long as long as they are members in good standing.

Section E. Place of Meetings

Meetings shall be held at the principal place of business unless otherwise announced.

Section F. Meetings

Meetings shall be held simultaneously with general membership meetings.

Section G. Officers

1. The officers of this corporation shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

2. The officers shall have all the duties and responsibilities usually attending their offices.

3. The Board of Directors shall select any other officers or committee chairpersons as it deems necessary.

4. Each officer shall serve for one year.

Article VII Amendment of By-Laws

These By-Laws may be amended or repealed by a majority vote of the membership at any general meeting provided the proposed amendment has been publicized at least twenty-four hours in advance.
